Kingdom Oneness: What We're Called To

- Grow wide **acceptance** within Colonial for racial healing as an expression of the full gospel.
- Create a dramatic increase in **racial healing awareness, understanding, and empathy** that leads to serving and diverse relationship building.
- Present **worship** that welcomes all in a Kingdom atmosphere that expresses “we have a place for you here so come and join us” without needing to assimilate.
- Generate strong partnerships for serving our community with people from **minority churches**.
- Increase **community engagement** at both SKC and OP sites that leads to flourishing of our neighborhoods, church growth, evangelism, and discipleship.

Kingdom Oneness: What You'll See Us Doing

- Teaching and relationship building classes
- Messages from the pulpit on racial healing and what Colonial believes
- Resource distribution for crises needs primarily for the food insecure
- Community development in areas of education, jobs and housing in cooperation with other ministries like Center Impact and Freedom Fire
- Serving our communities along with Black churches
- Developing a “Kingdom atmosphere” for worship in music, preaching and patterns of worship
- SKC- or OP-specific community engagement that fosters racial healing, congregational growth, evangelism, and discipleship

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
