Campus Worship Leader- Worship & Arts – Part Time

SUMMARY

The Campus Worship leader of Colonial Presbyterian will coordinate and lead the worship music portion of the Sunday morning service. They will prepare the members of the campus band and vocal team in presenting a weekly worship celebration that is musically compelling and submitted to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. They will also collaborate with the Director of Worship and Arts and other campus worship leader in finding and selecting songs, hymns, scriptures, prayers, and readings that help to create a sacred environment for both sites and exemplify the corporate worship philosophy of the church. This is a part time position - (6 hours per week).

Collaborates with: Director of Worship and Arts and other campus worship leader

ESSENTIAL DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Create a weekly worship package that follows the church's format and philosophy of worship
2. Lead the music, singing and spirit of worship for the Sunday morning services and Christmas Eve services.
3. Participate as needed in worship events (Walk to the Manger, Good Friday)
4. Plan, coordinate and lead occasional worship recordings for online services.
5. Plan and lead weekly rehearsals with band and vocal team
6. Provide and review all needed music, lyrics, resources and set-ups for weekly services with Worship and Arts Administrator
7. Meet weekly with Director of Worship and Arts and other campus worship leader for long-range planning and finding/selecting new worship materials

JOB SPECIFICATIONS / COMPETENCIES (skills/gifts, knowledge, abilities, behaviors)

1. A personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and the understanding of the importance of worship.
2. Strong giftedness in the area of leadership and vocal performance
3. Proficiency in piano or guitar coupled with experience/background in playing/working with bands/instrumental groups
4. Ability to provide clear musical direction and instruction for both vocalists and instrumentalists.
5. Sound knowledge of both hymns and contemporary worship music
6. Ability to read music preferred

WORKING CONDITIONS

1. Ability to stand for 20-30 minutes at a time
2. Flexible hours
